



Braided Horns

1. Make a triangular parting for the bangs and take them aside.
2. Take medium sized locks of hairs from the top of the head in a ponytail high on the head above the ears.
3. Now take the bangs and make Dutch braid all the way to the end. Let the braid lie down over the center parting.
4. Take a medium sized lock from one ponytail, divide it in three, and make a traditional braid all the way to the end. Repeat throughout the ponytail, until you have made three braids.
5. Do the same on the other side.
6. Now braid the three braids together in the same way as you make a traditional braid and fasten them at the end. Take the large braid and pull half of it through into a ponytail.
7. Note that you should not pull all the hair through the elastic.
8. Use the end of the big braid to conceal the elastics by wrapping it around the elastic on both sides.
9. Pull the horns into shape and fasten them securely with hairpins.
